## **International Scientific Collaborations in Iceland**

Research activites at the Science Institute, University of Iceland will be summarized, with empahsis on geosciences. Existing international collaborations will be discussed and the arrangements used for the collaborations at the Science Institute will be explained. In particular, the setup of the highly successful collaboration with the National Institute of Polar Research in Japan will be outlined, as well as the involvement with the SuperDARN project and the operation of its two radars in Iceland. The upcoming collaboration with the Polar Research Institute of China will also be discussed. The emphasis in the presentation will be on the upper atmosphere research, but examples from seismology, volcanology, glaciology and other fields will also be given.
